Over a period of one week, student volunteers spoke to the students about the importance of contributing to this drive and encouraged all to go back home and sieve through their treasure boxes to identify the things they would love to share with another person who is not so privileged. The hard work yielded good result. The college collected huge number of clothes, footwear and toys. Student volunteers worked diligently over a span of one week to segregate the belongings pack them into boxes and label them for easy identification and distribution.
