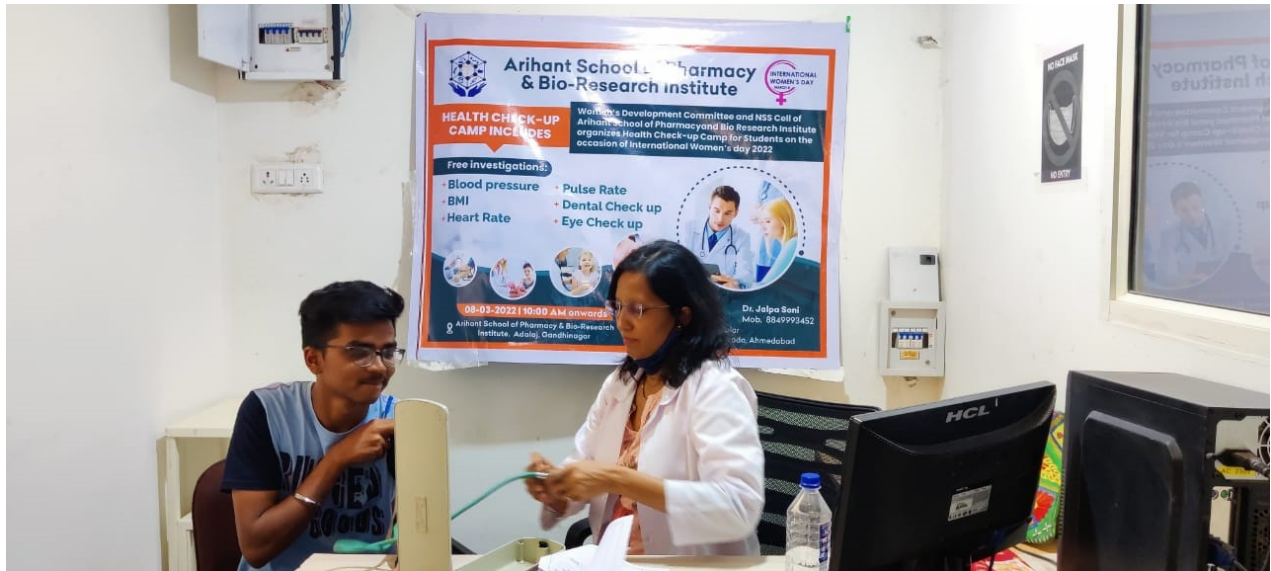
**Outcome of Event:** In this camp, about 100 students as well as 20 staff members were actively participated.

**TOTAL PARTICIPANTS:** Total 22 students have participated in the camp.

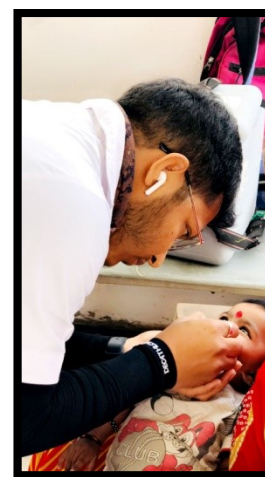
**Objective of Event:** To create awareness and importance of Polio vaccination among community

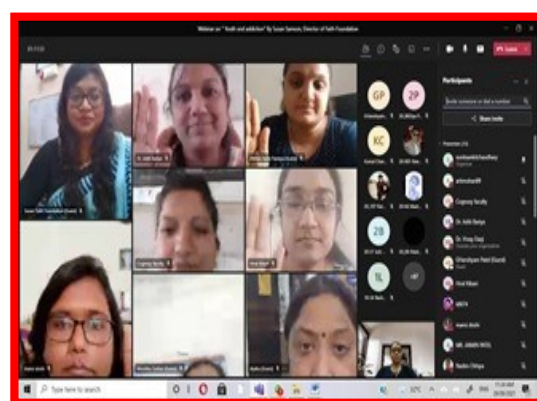
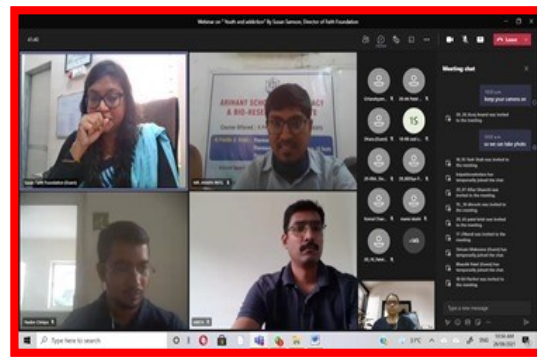
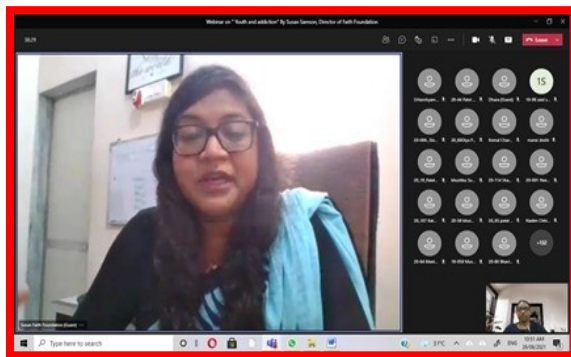
**Description of Programme:**

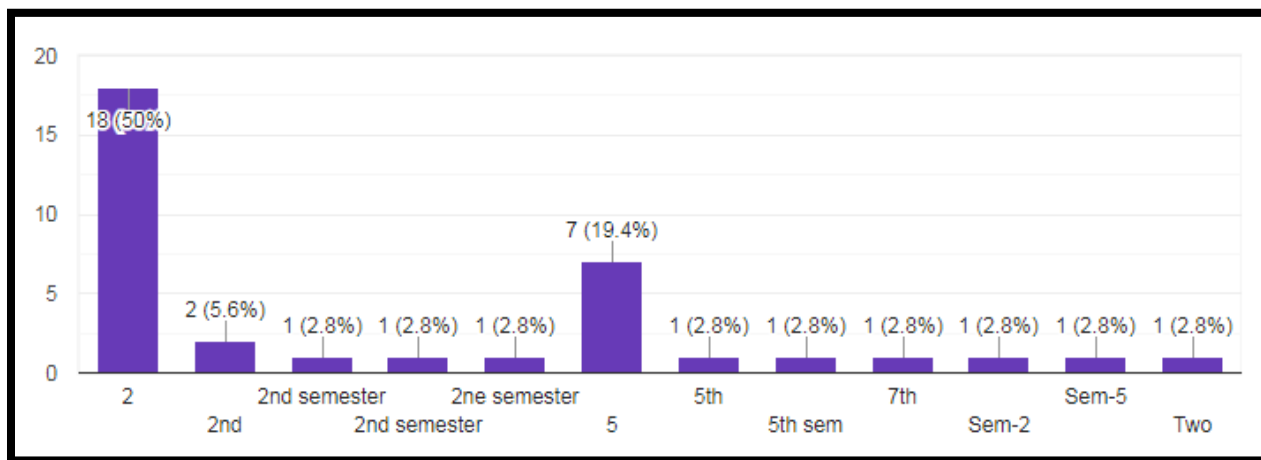
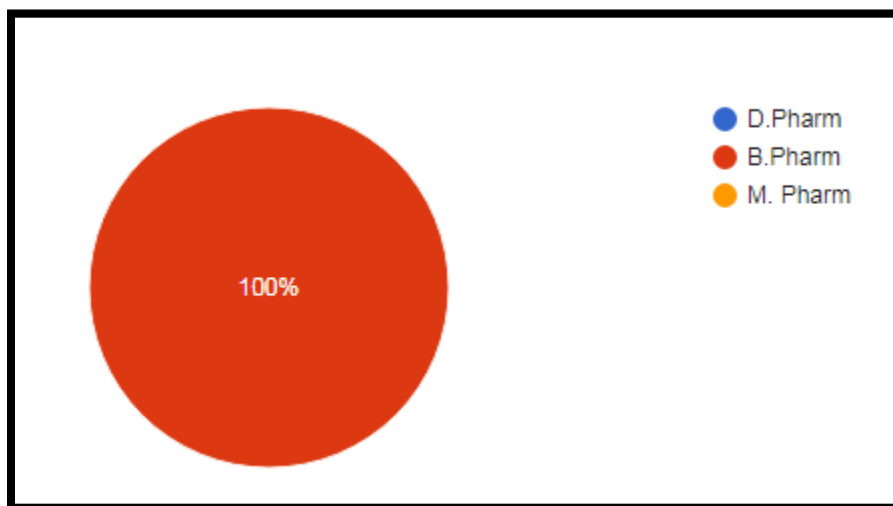

**TOTAL PARTICIPANTS:** 34 students of D. Pharm, B.Pharm and M.Pharm

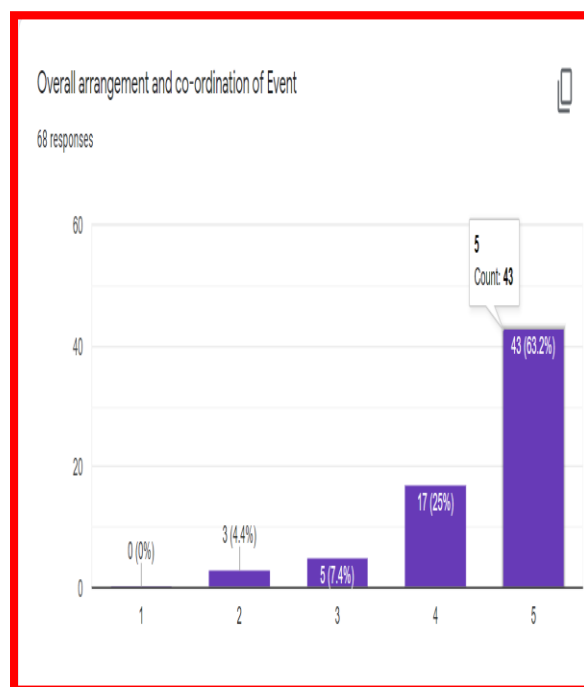
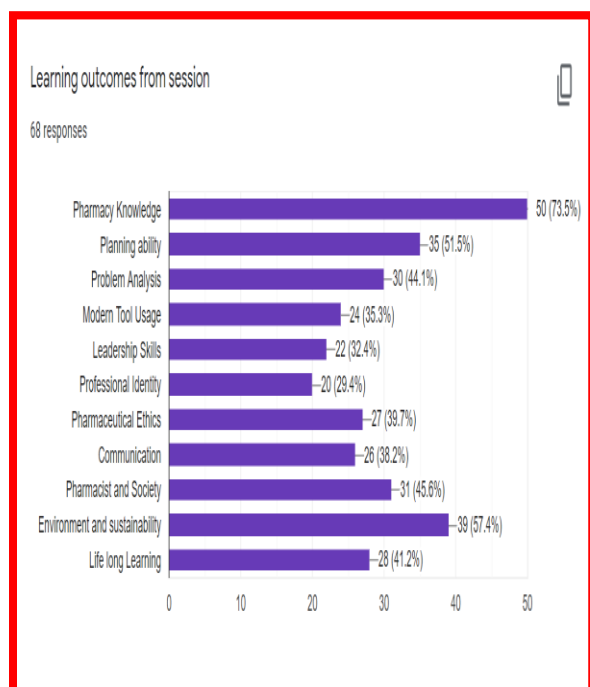
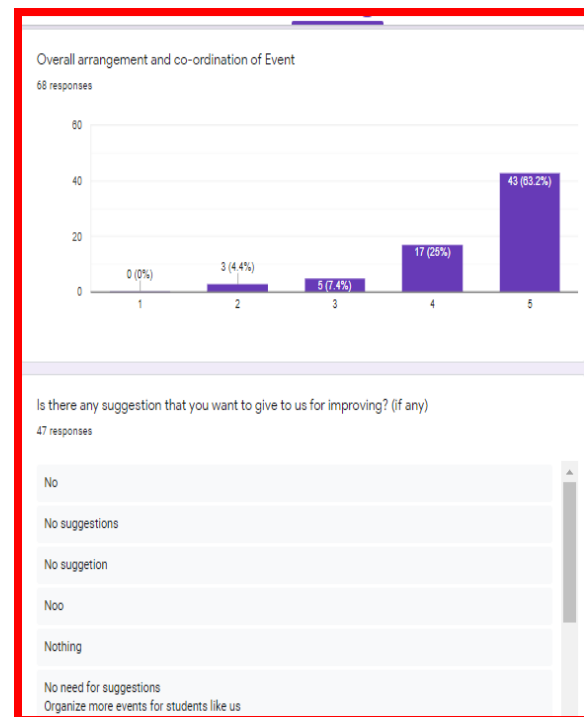
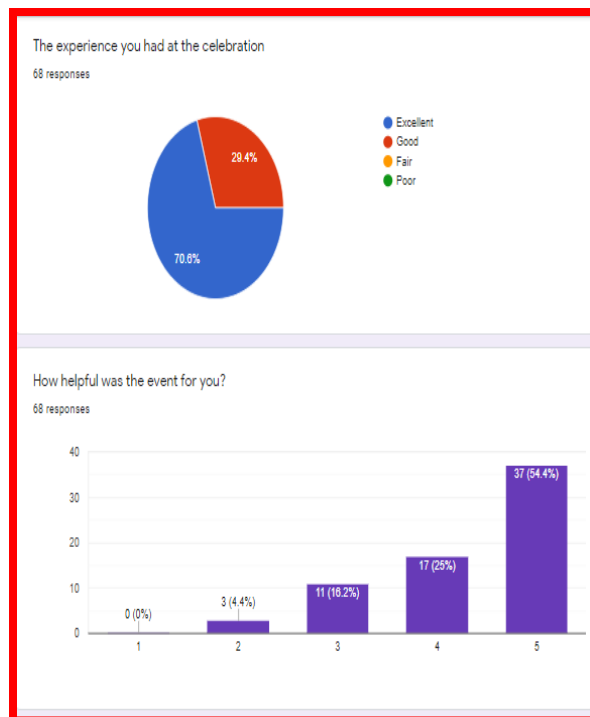
**Objective of Event:** To create environment awareness amongst faculties, PG and UG students.
